Saving/Tagging

Judicial authority is lacking on the question of whether once crystallisation has occurred, a chargee may agree with the chargor that the charge be treated once more as a floating charge - the possibility of "de-crystallisation" or "refloatation" has been recognised by certain commentators - the best way to resolve increasing adaptation of the floating charge to the security needs of the chargee is to introduce legislation designed to curtail the chargee's powers.
