Registration

Students must register to access **mentor**. To register, click on the Register button on the right hand side of the screen.



All fields are required to be completed. Your email address is required so your password can be emailed to you and your date of birth is required so that if you forget your password you can request a new one.



Your details are saved so that each time you log in to **mentor** your previous quizzes and results are recorded and you can either resume from where you left off, or restart exercises if you want to attempt any again for revision.

The last field on the registration page is optional and will only apply if your lecturer provides you with a password to access the lecturer assessment tools. If your lecturer has provided you with a password, enter it now. If not, leave the field blank. You will have the opportunity to edit your details if your lecturer gives you a password at a later date.

Upon successful registration a notification screen will appear, indicating that an automaticallygenerated password has been sent to your email address.

Please note that registration in **mentor** is on a subject by subject basis and to access other modules (eg Corporations Law and also Guide to Business Law) will require separate registrations. However, you can use the same details each time you register.

Check your emails and then go back to the login page (your email will have a link) and log in using your email address and the automatically generated password you have been provided.



As soon as you log in you will be prompted to set your own password. Your password should be at least 6 letters long, can contain both letters and numbers, and is case sensitive.

Other features

You can add important dates and notes to the calendar in the top left of your screen.



Click on a date and an "Add notes" pane will appear. Enter your note and click save. That date will then be highlighted in blue to indicate its importance. Clicking on the highlighted date will bring up the related note. If you have access to the lecturer modules then your lecturer can also add important dates to your calendar (assignment due dates etc).

Please note that this password is confidential. Assessments undertaken in the lecturer modules are viewed by your lecturer. Any users who are **not** students recognised by that lecturer will have their access to the lecturer modules blocked by the lecturer.



Once you have entered the password provided from your lecturer you will be able to see the topics that your lecturer has assigned to your class. Lecturer-provided content will always appear within orange borders, so you can easily identify the student and lecturer modules.

Your lecturer may have written a customised welcome message and instructions in the top right hand corner of the page. He/she may also have included some documents to download to assist you in your studies.

He/she may have scheduled some tasks for you to complete which will be listed in the Scheduled tasks pane on the left hand side below your calendar. Some of these tasks may involve completing **mentor** exercises, but could be other assessment tasks that you are required to complete. The due dates for these items will be highlighted in your calendar. When you tick the box next to your scheduled task your lecturer will be notified that you have completed it.

Important note – When you undertake review quizzes in the lecturer modules be aware that:

- You may only attempt each question, and each quiz ONCE;
- The correct answers will NOT be revealed; and
- Your lecturer will receive notification of your results.

This part of **mentor** is for your lecturer to assess your understanding of course materials and content.

Some lecturers may allocate these topics to you as revision tools only, but your lecturer may elect to use these tools as part of your formal assessment or as part of your class participation mark, where applicable.
